WIPR-TV'S PRE-TRANSITION DIGITAL OPERATIONS ON CHANNEL 55 TERMINATED EARLY TO ACCOMMODATE EQUIPMENT FOR ITS POST-TRANSITION DIGITAL OPERATIONS ON CHANNEL 43 AND REMAINED SILENT FOR THE ENTIRE SECOND QUARTER. RESPONDENT NEEDED TO COORDINATE ITS TRANSITION TO CHANNEL 43 WITH WSUR-DT WHICH WAS USING CHANNEL 43 FOR ITS PRE-TRANSITION DIGITAL OPERATIONS. ACCORDINGLY, WIPR-TV WAS NOT BROADCASTING IN DIGITAL UNTIL JUNE 13, 2009. THEREFORE, ALTHOUGH THE STATION WAS NOT SIMULCASTING ITS ANALOG AND DIGITAL					

OPERATIONS, IT WILL NOT SUBMIT A SEPARATE FORM 388 FOR ITS DIGITAL STREAM BECAUSE THERE WAS NO ADDITIONAL DIGITAL PROGRAMMING TO REPORT.
